Student Papers, i.e., papers that report research conducted by one or more graduate or undergraduate students, are eligible for the Student Paper Contest. The first author of such a paper must be currently enrolled as a graduate or undergraduate student in an institution of higher learning. If your paper should be considered as a Student Paper, please indicate it as such when uploading the paper

## Author Instructions

---

Prospective authors should submit the final camera-ready copy of their papers electronically (PDF) format for review. Papers must be no more than 8 pages in length on 8 1/2"x 11" (letter size paper) and formatted as per the IEEE PES Guidelines for Authors. Papers are to be submitted through the conference web site.

As per NAPS regulations, a statement that one of the authors will attend and present the paper must accompany papers. The deadline for full submission of papers is June 15, 2008.
